

Bueno Verde Bermudagrass is a blend of Giant & VNS bermudagrass, specifically designed for forage use and hay production. Bueno Verde provides the best forage for permanent pastures in the desert southwest. It handles poor soils with high Ph, high salinity, is drought tolerant and will grow in areas where other grasses struggle. Bermudagass is a warm season permanent grass that spreads via rhizomes and stolons and goes dormant in the winter.

Plant 15 lbs./acre drilled or broadcast in full sun when nighttime temperatures are consistently 65°F and getting warmer, with a minimum 6 weeks of establishment prior to first frost. For optimum results, use a preplant fertilizer with approx. 35#/acre of Nitrogen. If grazing, apply Nitrogen at a rate of 150 lbs./acre annually, split up during growing season, if cutting for hay, apply 40-50 lbs./acre per month during the growing season, being careful to make last application 6-8 weeks prior to first frost. A soil test is recommended for optimum levels of other nutrients. Bueno Verde is a drought tolerant grass, however to reduce damage to the pasture, it is important to rotate animals more frequently during drought stress.

Year round forage can be accomplished by overseeding with Winter Pasture Mixture after a minimum of 100 days or preferably 1 year growth to fully establish the pasture.

Planting Rates

Pasture: 10-15 lbs. (4.54 to 6.80 kg) per acre drilled or broadcast (new pasture)

8-12 lbs. (3.63 to 5.44 kg) per acre drilled or broadcast (to thicken existing stand)
