Bermudagrass Seed

Cynodon dactylon



Giant bermudagrass was developed from selections out of common bermudagrass in the 1960's. Is similar in appearance to Coastal Bermudagrass without the winter hardiness. Fast, vigorous tall growth that recovers rapidly after cutting or pasturing by spreading with both rhizomes and stolons. Is highly tolerant to drought, heavy grazing and a wide range of soils. Uses include grazing, hay, silage and pelletizing.

Bermudagrass is a warm season permanent grass that spreads via rhizomes and stolons and goes dormant in the winter. Plant in full sun when nighttime temperatures are consistently 65° and getting warmer, with at least 6 weeks of establishment prior to first frost. For year round grazing, overseeding with winter pasture mixture is suggested.

Available in Hulled, Unhulled & Coated Seeds

Hulled Seed: (2,000,000 seeds per lb) Has the outer skin mechanically removed to speed up germination. This makes it more likely for the seed to all germinate at near the same time. More hulled seed is planted than any other kind.

Unhulled Seed: (1,400,000 seeds per lb) Has the natural outer skin still intact. Takes 7-10 days longer to germinate than hulled seed.

Coated Seed: (700,000—1,000,000 seeds per lb) Has been coated with a clay based material with trace nutrients to increase successful germination by providing nutrients at the time of germination.

Planting Rates

Broadcast: 10-20 lbs. per acre

Drill: 10 lbs. per acre in 20 inch rows
