For best results plant Zenith seed in the spring or summer when soil temperatures are above 65 to 70 degrees.

New Lawns

1. Prepare the seed bed by tilling and raking smooth.
2. Remove sticks and stones larger than 1 inch in diameter.
3. Rake in 10 pounds per 1000 sq ft of a 5-10-15 fertilizer or equivalent.

Old Lawn Renovation

1. Spray existing grass (conversion of bermudagrass lawns is impractical) and weeds with Roundup or similar at label rates.
2. Remove by scalping--dead weeds and grasses.
3. Apply 10 pounds per 1000 sq ft of a 5-10-15 fertilizer or equivalent then aerify the surface and drag smooth.



Seeding and Grow-in Instructions

1. Seed with Zenith Zoysia seed at the rate of 1 pound of seed per 1000 sq ft. Divide seed volume in half and distribute in two directions.
2. Begin watering immediately and keep soil moist until germination--about 2 to 3 weeks.
3. Mow as soon as weeds or grass at an initial cutting height of 1 to 1 1/2" inches.
4. Apply weed control chemicals once plants have established.
5. Fertilize with 7 pounds per 1,000 sq ft of 16-4-8 or equivalent every 3 weeks until cover.
6. Once established follow this simple maintenance schedule:

- Mow at 1-1/2 inch height
- Water only as needed
- Fertilize and control weeds as follows

Early Spring	10 lbs 5-10-15 + Iron*	Pre-Emerge
Late Spring	7 lbs 16-4-8- + Iron*	As Needed
Early Summer	7 lbs 16-4-8- + Iron*	As Needed
Late Summer	7 lbs 16-4-8- + Iron*	As Needed
Fall	10 lbs 5-10-15 + Iron*	Pre-Emerge

* Apply per 1000 sq ft of lawn
